ITEM NO. 6: REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION

RFI-1.

Question: City Ordinances require Contractors to provide rodent abatement at all construction sites where any

soil disruption will occur. These ordinances include both demolition and new construction sites, and require the contrator to have a pest control plan developed and implemented by a licensed pest control provider. Will rodent abatement be included as a line item in the scope of all public building

commission projects that include any digging or soil disruption?

Response: PBC adheres to all City Ordinances (as applicable) on all projects.

RFI-2.

Question: Since the pricing for the PBC Job Order Contracting Services has to come from the Gordian CTC,

how does the Gordian CTC account for sudden or drastic market changes, resulting in material

inflation costs, that occur before the annual updates?

Response: For Base Year:

The CTC has included the September 2018 ENR CCI cost data. There is no adjustment during the one year period. Proposers should take any expected material price spikes or risk of price spikes into

account when developing their factors.

For Annual Year Adjustment:

The adjustment factors are updated annually per the ENR CCI cost data. The ENR CCI Adjustment would take into account a material price spike and be higher than it would be if the material price

spike did not occur.

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RFI-3.

Question: With regard to FORM A - TECHNICAL COMPETENCE AND PAST PERFORMANCE (p. 22 of 137),

when proposing as a JV, are 5 projects required from each partner of JV or 5 total collectively?

Response: If the Joint Venture has previously completed projects together, submit FORM A for the Joint Venture.

If not, submit FORM A for five (5) projects for each member of the Joint Venture.

RFI-4.

Question: 7) SAFETY PROGRAM MANUAL: (Applicable to Tier 3 Respondents only) Respondents should be

able to demonstrate the quality of their overall safety program as evidenced by their history of

citations, OSHA incident rate and Experience Modification Rate (EMR).

For purposes of this RFP, Tier 3 Respondents must complete FORM F – SAFETY and submit a copy

of the Table of Contents of the Safety Program Manual.

Q: If responding as a JV, do you need a FORM F (and corresponding information) and a T.O.C. of

Safety Program for each JV Partner?

Response: If the Joint Venture has previously completed projects together, submit FORM F for the Joint

Venture. If not, submit FORM F for each member of the Joint Venture and TOC of Safety Program for

each member of the Joint Venture.

RFI-5.

Question: 8) QUALITY ASSURANCE AND QUALITY CONTROL PLAN (QA/QC): (Applicable to Tier 3

Respondents only) Respondents should be able to demonstrate their experience with

implementation of QA/QC processes.

For purposes of this RFP, Tier 3 Respondents must submit a copy of their Quality Assurance and

Quality Control Plan.

Note to Tier 1, 2, and 3 Respondents: PBC reserves the right to request QA/QC information during

the solicitation of this RFP or prior to Job Order being issued under a resultant contract.

Q: If responding as a JV, do you need a sample QA/QC control plan for each JV Partner? Can the

Sample QA/QC plan be for a previous PBC job?

Response: If the Joint Venture has previously completed projects together, submit QA/QC for the Joint Venture.

If not, submit QA/QC for each member of the Joint Venture. Samples cannot be from previous PBC

jobs.

RFI-6.

Question: 9) PROJECT SCHEDULING: (Applicable to Tier 3 Respondents only) The PBC may require General

Contractors to submit schedules electronically or utilize scheduling software for project management purposes.

For purposes of this RFP, Tier 3 Respondents must submit a sample of a project schedule.

Note to Tier 1, 2, and 3 Respondents: PBC reserves the right to request Project Scheduling information during the solicitation of this RFP or prior to Job Order being issued under a resultant

contract.

Sample Project Schedule be for a previous PBC job?

Response: If the Joint Venture has previously completed projects together, submit Project Schedule for the

Joint Venture. If not, submit Project Schedule for each member of the Joint Venture. Samples

cannot be from previous PBC jobs.

RFI-7.

Question: Your page 35 of 137 – second from last item. I need to know whether it's an actual violation or just a

shortfall - and here's why I'm asking. In one of our Zones for our 2FM projects, we had a minor

shortfall in MBE, but more than compensated in our WBE percentages coming in at \$24.45%

Response: If you have been investigated or assessed a penalty, you should check 'Yes' and provide a brief

description and/or explanation. If you were not assessed or investigated for your shortfall, then your

answer is 'No'.
