new 1-story, approx. 27,000 sf





EC115 Site Limits









EC115 Floor Plan

MBE or WBE firms must be certified with the City of Chicago and/or Cook County to receive credit as an MBE/WBE firm by the PBC.






City Residency & Community Hiring
