Commissioner Maldonado then presented a report by the Administrative Operations (AO)

follows:

The Chief of Staff reported on one task order award for Specialty Consultant Services and one task order award for Architect of Record Services to previously appointed firms.

The Chief of Staff reported on the Design Build Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Report for various projects. She also reported on the recommendation to appoint two firms to provide feasibility studies and two firms to provide Architect of Record services. The Executive Director will provide details on these recommendations during her report.

The Chief of Staff also reported on a recommendation to approve amendments to Ebuilder for Electronic Project Management and Technical Support Systems and to McLaren Software Limited (CW) for Document Management and Business Process Systems. These amendments are for time only and provide for two-year extensions to the term of the agreements.

The Chief Development Officer reported on field orders issued and provided a recommendation to approve Change Orders for nine projects, as follows:

- A Change Order in the amount of \$35,745.05 for work at the Esmond Elementary School Annex and Renovation Project. Change Orders for unused allowances in the credit amount of (\$215.51) at the Lincoln Park High School Renovation, in the credit amount of (\$152,881.61) at the Ebinger Elementary School Annex and Renovation, and in the credit amount of (\$142,267.93) at the Taft Freshman Academy Project.
- Change Orders for work at Group A Chicago Park District Projects for Facility Renovations at LaFollette Park in the amount of \$950.50 and Columbus Park in the credit amount of (\$8,991.56). A change order for work at the Williams Park Fieldhouse in the amount of \$149,380.55.
- Change Orders for Liquidated Damages assessed in the credit amount (\$16,753.08) at the Douglas Park Facility Renovation and in the credit amount of (\$53,313.83) for Group B Chicago Park District Facility Renovation Projects.

Finally, the Executive Director extended Holiday Greetings on behalf of the Public Building

Commission including its Staff and Commissioners. The Executive Director's Report was accepted at the conclusion of her presentation.

The Commissioners were advised that the proposed project would include the design and construction of a new annex and associated site development work with a budget in the amount of \$39,030,000 pursuant to the Fiscal Year 2021 Capital Improvement Plan approved by the Board of Education at its August 26, 2020 Board Meeting. The Undertaking Request includes professional, technical, construction, administrative and management services but does not include items to be provided by the Board of Education, such as: fixtures, furniture and equipment, Chicago Public Schools Project Management, IT equipment and textbooks.
