WITNESSETH, that the Contractor and the Commission for the consideration stated herein agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 STATEMENT OF WORK

The Contractor agrees to perform everything required to be performed and to provide all of the labor, necessary tools, machinery and materials, and all facilities for the construction of the project as described herein and as further identified in the "Request for Prequalification" for this project and other work necessary to perform and complete in a workmanlike manner, and within the specified time, all of the Work listed in the foregoing Advertisement for Bids dated March 30, 2001 in strict accordance with the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 2 TIME OF PERFORMANCE

Time is of the essence of this Contract. The Contractor agrees that it will commence the performance of the Work on the date set forth in the Notice to Proceed issued by the Commission and that it will complete the Work within the time set forth in the Special Conditions.

ARTICLE 6 COVENANT AGAINST CONTINGENT FEES

The Contractor warrants that it has not employed any person to solicit or secure this Contract upon any agreement for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee. Breach of this warranty shall give the Commission the right to terminate the Contract, or, in its discretion, to deduct from the contract price or consideration the amount of such commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fees. This warranty shall not apply to any commission payable by the Contractor upon contracts or sales secured or made through bona fide established commercial or selling agencies maintained by the Contractor for the purpose of securing business

BASIS OF CONTRACT AWARD (Award Criteria)

To promote the intended goal of affirmative action and maximize the use of minority personnel on this project, the Public Building Commission of Chicago has established the Award Criteria formula for the purpose of evaluating proposals and awarding the contract. A contract in the amount of the total Base Bid or Base Contract Price will be awarded to the responsible bidder with the lowest Award Criteria Figure. The Public Building Commission of Chicago reserves the right to check all calculations for correctness. The fulfillment of the Award Criteria does not abrogate the responsibilities of the contractor to comply with federal and state requirements under the Equal Employment Act and the Illinois Human Rights Act.

INSTRUCTIONS

The Bidder shall complete the Award Criteria Formula and transfer the final Award Criteria Figure - Line 15 to the space provided on the itemized proposal sheet. Failure to complete the formula may be cause for rejection of the Bidder's proposal. The successful bidder will be held responsible for adhering to the figures submitted in Lines 1, 2, 4, 6, 10 and 12 during construction of the project.

Lines 2, 4 and 6 in the formula shall not be greater than fifty percent (50%) in each category for the purpose only of determining award of the contract. Similarly, lines 8, 10 and 12 shall not be greater than ten (10%) percent in each category for the purpose of award criteria only. The fifty percent (50%) and ten percent (10%) goals are not intended to restrict the total number of minority and female employees to be used on the project, but only to establish limiting figures for use in the formula. Journeyworker includes journeyworkers from the major trades listed herein, and the teamsters. Watchmen and custodial workers are not creditable in the formula.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Contractor hereby consents and agrees that, in the event that it fails to comply with each of the minimum commitments submitted with this Proposal on Lines 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 or 12 of the Award Criteria Formula, covering minority and female Journeyworkers, apprentices, and laborers respectively, the following shall apply.

If the total hours in any category for which a percentage is assigned in Lines 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 or 12 of the Award Criteria equals zero at the completion of the work, then a net deficiency of the entire percentage assigned will be deemed to exist. For any net deficiency in each category, the following amounts shall be deducted as liquidated damages from monies due the Contractor and the Contract Sum modified accordingly:

a. For each full one (1%) percent deficiency of minority Journeyworkers not utilized – seventeen and ninety three hundredths cents per each hundred dollars of the base bid calculated as follows:

Line 1 x 0.1793

Each one (1%) percent deficiency toward the goal for female Journeyworkers (Line 8) shall be calculated in the same way.

b. For each full one (1%) percent deficiency of minority apprentices not utilized — sixteen and ninety three hundredths cents per hundred dollars of the base bid calculated as follows:

Line 1 x 0.1693

Each one (1%) percent deficiency toward the goal for female apprentices (Line 10) shall be calculated in the same way.

c. For each one (1%) percent deficiency of minority laborers not utilized — fourteen and ninety three hundredths cents per each hundred dollars of the base bid calculated as follows:

Line 1 x 0.1493 100 or other individuals found by the Public Building Commission of Chicago to be socially and economically disadvantaged and to have suffered actual racial or ethnic discrimination and decreased opportunities to compete in Chicago area markets.

The Contractor shall maintain data which records its good faith efforts to identify, train and/or hire lower-income residents from the project area and to utilize business concerns which are located in or owned in substantial part by persons residing in the area of the project.

BD-4(f) LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE

Since the cost of doing business is higher for firms located in the City of Chicago due to higher taxes and other operating expenses, and the City of Chicago benefits from the presence of those firms in the City, the Commission applies a Local Business Preference to bids on projects funded by the City of Chicago. To be considered a local business, a firm must.

be located within the corporate limits of the City of Chicago,

· have the majority of its regular, full-time work force located within the City of Chicago, and

be subject to City of Chicago taxes.

For City-funded projects, a contract in the amount of the total Base Bid will be awarded to the responsible local business submitting the lowest Award Criteria Figure, provided that the Award Criteria Figure does not exceed the lowest Award Criteria Figure submitted by a responsible non-local business by more than two percent (2%).

If the Bidder is a joint venture, the joint venture shall be considered a local business if:

all partners to the joint venture are Local Businesses, or

• one of the partners to the joint venture is a Local Business and holds at least a fifty percent (50%) interest in the joint venture.

A local business has a fifty percent (50%) interest in the joint venture only if it holds subcontracts equal to fifty percent (50%) or more of the amount of the bid. Joint venture bidders shall submit information and documentation (including, but not limited to, the joint venture agreement and subcontracts) with their bids to establish their eligibility for the Local Business Preference.

Each Bidder seeking classification as a Local Business must complete and sign the Affidavit of Local Business and shall submit documentation to support the assertions in the affidavit. The following documentation must be included with the affidavit:


