Lincoln Park W., Chicago, Illinois 60614. Attendees are to enter through West Entrance. Street parking is available but limited. Please arrive early.

An authorized representative of each Prequalified Bidder must be present and must sign in to both the Mandatory Technical Review Meeting and Site Visit Meetings' attendance sheets no later than 15 minutes after the scheduled start of the meetings on each day. Prequalified firms that do not sign-in on both Mandatory Technical Review attendance sheets and the Mandatory Site Visit Attendance sign-in sheets 15 minutes after commencement of each meeting will be deemed ineligible to bid.

Bidders shall be responsible for inspecting the Site to become familiar with the conditions relating to the Work to be performed, the facilities involved, and the site logistics required in the successful performance of this Contract. Failure of the Bidders to visit the Site shall not relieve or alter the Bidder's responsibility for completing the Work as required by the Contract Documents.
