RFI-1.

Question: Are we required to submit MBE/WBE Schedules C and D in Tab 5 of our proposal?

Response: The RFP contemplates a master term agreement whereby the requisite firm will submit a task specific proposal. Each proposal will need to be accompanied by completed Schedule C's and D's in order for an approved task order to be issued.

RFI-2.

- Question: There is Professional Liability Insurance required, Professional Liability applies to licensed Engineers and Architects – is there a requirement for these type of individuals? If not does and Errors and Omissions Policy suffice (in addition to the other insurance types outlined in 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3 of Exhibit E)
- **Response:** The Commission is not seeking an Architect and Engineer Professional Liability policy. The Commission needs evidence of Professional Liability insurance for the scope of services as outlined in the Constructability Review Services RFP.

RFI-3.

- Question: If we are successful in being awarded this RFP are we precluded from Architect and/or Engineering work on other projects??
- **Response:** Since each particular set of circumstances is unique, this will be addressed by the Commission on a case-by-case basis. Being awarded a contract under this RFP will not necessarily exclude the firm from Architect and/or Engineering work on other PBC projects.
