Chairman Lightfoot called the meeting to order, and the presence of a quorum was established.

There were no registered speakers for the public participation period, which was to be conducted pursuant to Section 2.06(g) of the Open Meetings Act.

The next item on the agenda was consideration of approval of the minutes of the rescheduled meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Public Building Commission held on December 17, 2019. The reading of said minutes, which had previously been distributed, was

dispensed with and upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the December 17, 2019 meeting were unanimously approved.

The next item on the agenda was the nomination and election of Paul Stewart as the Assistant Secretary of the Board of Commissioners of the Public Building Commission of Chicago for a term ending September 30, 2020. There being no other nominations, and upon motion duly made and seconded, Paul Stewart was unanimously elected as Assistant Secretary of the Board of Commissioners of the Public Building Commission for a term ending on September 30, 2020.

Commissioner Maldonado then provided a report by the Administrative Operations (AO) Committee regarding its meeting held on January 8, 2020 which is summarized as follows:

The Chief of Staff reported on five task order awards for Material Testing and Geotechnical specialty consultant services to previously appointed firms for various projects. A report was also provided on a task order award for Architect of Record Services to Brook Architecture, Inc., a Minority and Women Business Enterprise firm, for the Brooks College Prep Athletic Amenities Project.

The Chief Development Officer reported on field orders issued and provided a recommendation to approve a change order, as follows:

- A change order in the amount of \$54,433.04 to provide moisture mitigation to install vinyl flooring material at the Lincoln Park High School Renovation Project.

The AO Committee accepted the recommendations and reports from the PBC representatives.

A copy of the Task Order Report is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Following consideration of the AO Committee report and upon motion duly made and seconded, the following Resolution was adopted by the Board of Commissioners:

The next item on the agenda was a report by Executive Director Sánchez regarding regular reports, development status and other matters. She presented a power point display and reported that the Public Building Commission of Chicago’s 2019 Year in Review will be reported at the March 2020 Board Meeting. The report noted that 20 capital projects were completed during 2019 and workers earned more than \$71M working on those projects. The report also featured the continued success of the Design Build and Construction Management project delivery methods used on PBC projects. The report included photographs of the Daley College MTEC (completed in 2019), Englewood STEM High School (completed in 2019), Hancock College Prep Replacement High School (under construction), and Engine Company 115 (under construction). The Executive Director noted that, during 2019, the Public Building Commission continued its commitment to ensuring that Minority and Women Business Enterprise Firms are given opportunities for growth. Further, PBC’s Quarterly Newsletter was successfully utilized to keep clients, elected officials and stakeholders informed about current PBC activities and opportunities. Ongoing communication is maintained to connect more than 8,000 individuals and organizations to PBC through the electronically distributed newsletter and PBC alerts. Finally, the Executive Director advised that PBC is implementing e-builder, PBC’s

new construction project management software solution to better serve their clients and that the PBC is proud to support and promote City-wide initiatives such as an “Invest South West” and the “2020 Census”.

At the conclusion of the discussion, the report by the Executive Director was accepted.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
