The reading of the minutes of the January 8, 2020 Administrative Operations Committee meeting, which was previously distributed, was dispensed with. Upon motion duly made and seconded the minutes were unanimously adopted.

Pursuant to Section 2.06(g) of the Open Meetings Act, a public comment period was held. No comments or statements were presented by any persons.

The Chief of Staff reported on following recommendations;

Task order awards for Material Testing services in the amount of \$223,950 to Interra, Inc., a Minority Business Enterprise firm, for the Decatur Classical Elementary Annex Renovation Project, in the amount of \$258,750 to GSG Material Testing, Inc., a Minority Business Enterprise firm, for the Dirksen Elementary School Renovation Project and in the amount of \$473,622 to ECS Midwest for the Hancock Replacement School Project.

A report was provided on a task order awards for Architect of Record services to Bailey Edward Design, Inc., a Women Business Enterprise firm, for the following Park District Rehabilitation projects; Austin Town Hall in the amount of \$9,153.75, Columbus Park in the amount of \$9,416.25, LaFollette Park in the amount of \$6,538.75 and the Lincoln Park Cultural Center in the amount of \$5,074.50. Task orders in the amount of \$36,429 to Muller & Muller, Ltd., a Women Business Enterprise firm, for the Decatur Classical Elementary, in the amount of \$6,200 to Moody Nolan, Inc. for the Poe Classical Elementary School Annex and Renovation project and in the amount of \$5,970 to STL Architects, a Minority and Business Enterprise firm, for the Taft Freshman Academy (FKA Read Dunning School).

A report was provided on the procurement underway for the selection of an Architect/Engineer of Record for the Salt Dome Replacement Facility on Grand Avenue. PBC consulted its Letters of Interest and Qualifications database to identify experienced architectural and engineering firms with municipal and or civil engineering experience to serve as the Architect or Engineer of Record on this project.

As a result of that review and following an information session and site visit, proposals were received from five firms. The PBC convened an Evaluation Committee who assessed firms based on their experience, proposed project team, project approach and demonstrated commitment or MBE/WBE participation. Three firms were selected to attend follow-up meetings. PBC intends to complete the process and provide a recommendation at the February Board Meeting.

The Chief of Staff reported on the Design Build (Exhibit A) and Construction Manager (Exhibit B) Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Reports for seventeen projects. Following review of scope, schedule, budget and other project factors, staff negotiated the current GMP for the projects.

The AO Committee accepted the reports from the Chief of Staff.

Commissioner Camargo abstained on the task order report for material testing services to Interra, Inc.

- A Change Order in the amount of \$122,069.68 for Issue for Construction Permit revisions in multiple disciplines including; civil, landscaping, architectural, structural and electrical at the Taft Freshman Academy Project.
- Two Change Orders totaling \$413,952.19 for the Esmond School Annex and Renovation Project, including a Change Order for revisions associated with the fire suppression system and required fire watch in the amount of \$12,446.15 along with a Change Order for the Issue for Construction permit review and coordination comments in multiple disciplines, including architectural, mechanical, site environmental, fire suppression, plumbing, roofing, fencing, masonry, landscaping food service and electrical in the amount of \$401,506.04.
