

PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION MINUTES OF THE VIRTUAL ADMINISTRATIVE OPERATIONS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 3, 2021

The virtual meeting of the Administrative Operations Committee of the Public Building Commission of Chicago was held via Zoom on February 3, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. The meeting was livestreamed on the PBC's YouTube and Facebook accounts.

The reading of the minutes of the November 23, 2020 Administrative Operations Committee meeting, which was previously distributed, was dispensed with. Upon motion duly made and seconded the minutes were unanimously adopted.

Pursuant to Section 2.06(g) of the Open Meetings Act, a public comment period was held. No comments or statements were presented by any persons.

Carina E. Sánchez, PBC's Executive Director, reported on the bid opening for Contract #1598 for the Salt Dome Replacement Facility at Grand Avenue. Thirty-four (34) Class A and Class B general contractors were eligible to bid on the contract for the project. The project includes a new salt dome and site improvements to the existing salt storage and distribution site located at 2555 W. Grand Avenue. The project undertaking was approved by the board on December 17, 2019 with an undertaking amount of \$12,000,000. PBC received seven bids earlier today that are under review with an anticipated recommendation for award at the February 9, 2021 Board Meeting.

The AO Committee accepted the report from the Executive Director.
