PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION OF CHICAGO MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS HELD OVER A VIRTUAL PLATFORM WITH LIMITED IN PERSON ATTENDANCE AT THE RICHARD J. DALEY CENTER ON APRIL 11, 2023 AT 2:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lightfoot, and the presence of a quorum was established.

Following the roll call, a public participation period was conducted pursuant to Section 2.06(g) of the Open Meetings Act. George Blakemore had previously registered to provide comments under the guidelines established by Resolution No. 7611 approved by the Board of Commissioners on January 11, 2011. George Blakemore stated that 30% of the workers on Phase 2 of the Joint Public Safety Training Campus should be African American. He also expressed appreciation to Mayor Lightfoot for bringing the National Democratic Convention to Chicago, for her service during Covid-19 and Black Lives Matter, and for her guidance and determination.

Following the public comment period, Chairman Lightfoot presented to the Board for consideration of approval the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held on March 14, 2023. The reading of said minutes, which had previously been distributed, was dispensed with and upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the March 14, 2023 board meeting were unanimously approved.

The next item on the agenda was a report by Commissioner Maldonado regarding the Administrative Operations (AO) Committee virtual meeting held on April 5, 2023. Commissioner Maldonado's report regarding the AO Committee meeting is summarized as follows:

The Director of Procurement reported on one task order that was issued for surveyor services to Terra Engineering, Ltd., a WBE firm, for the Engine Company 44 Project in the amount of \$19,200.00.

The Director of Procurement reported on the Construction Manager Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Report for various projects.

The Chief Development Officer reported that two Field Orders under the reporting threshold were issued.

The AO Committee accepted the recommendations and reports from the PBC representatives.

A copy of the Construction Manager Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) Report is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"**.

The next item on the agenda was consideration of approval of a Revised Undertaking Request from the City of Chicago Department of Assets, Information and Services (AIS) for the Joint Public Safety Training Campus Phase IA: Outlot Restaurant Area located at 4443 West Chicago Avenue (the "Project"). The Revised Undertaking Request confirmed a revised funding authority of \$17,950,000 for the Project, including the planning, design and construction of the

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outlot restaurant buildings and associated site development in the restaurant areas. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the following Resolution was adopted:

The final item on the agenda was consideration of approval of a Revised Undertaking Request from the City of Chicago Department of Assets, Information and Services (AIS) for the Joint Public Safety Training Campus Phase 2: Outdoor Scenario Structures located at 4443 West Chicago Avenue (the "Project"). The Revised Undertaking Request confirmed a revised funding authority of \$39,680,000 for the Project, including the design and construction of the outdoor scenario structures and associated site development. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the following Resolution was adopted:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby approves the Revised Undertaking Request from the City of Chicago Department of Assets, Information and Services for the Joint Public Safety Training Campus Phase 2 – Outdoor Scenario Structures located at 4443 West Chicago Avenue in the amount of \$39,680,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director and appropriate officials of the Public Building Commission are hereby authorized and directed to undertake such action and to execute such documents, upon approval as to form and legality as may be approved by Legal Counsel, as may be necessary and appropriate in order to effectuate this Resolution.

At the conclusion of the regular meeting, there were expressions of gratitude and appreciation from several of the Commissioners regarding the leadership and service of Chairman Lightfoot during her tenure as Chairman of the Public Building Commissiom and Mayor of the City of Chicago. Commissioner Whittley noted that she had brought expanded services and opportunities to the west side and south side of Chicago. Commissioner Ellis acknowledged her strength and commitment to keep the City of Chicago well and thriving. Commissioner Maldonado expressed gratitude for her service. Commissioner Chapman also expressed appreciation for her service and robust leadership.

Following the remarks, Chairman Lightfoot stated that it had been her pleasure to serve as Chairman of the Public Building Commission. She noted that there is a continuing need to keep the Public Building Commission strong by assigning additional projects from other governmental agencies to the "pipeline" so that the Public Building Commission can continue to

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provide opportunities for minority-owned businesses and female-owned businesses and increase hiring of women and minorities and Chicago residents in the construction of public projects. Chairman Lighfoot thanked the PBC Executive Director and her staff and legal counsel for their hard work during her tenure.

Re: Notice of Awards to Specialty Consultant Services

Honorable Chairman and Commissioners:

In 2015, the PBC publicly advertised Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) from firms interested in providing consulting services in the following categories: Surveyor, among others. In December 2015 the PBC received approval to award term contracts to firms pre-qualified to provide specialty consulting services in these categories.

In February 2016, a random lottery by category was conducted to establish the rotation to accommodate the recent addition of firms. As services are required, the rotation determines the firm to which a request for pricing is issued. Proposals are reviewed and evaluated for experience, expertise of staff, capacity, past performance, plan of action proposed, and pricing. Upon approval, PBC staff issues a task order against the successful firm's term contract.
