01 Welcome, Introductions, Objectives, Project Overview

Project Overview

Partners:


Chicago Park District (CPD), the Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT), and The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) - Chicago District

- Shoal {SHol} a raised area of exposed bedrock under the surface of the water.
- Part of the multi-year, multi-phase Chicago Shoreline Protection Project.
- Located along the Lake Michigan shoreline between 45th and 51st Streets.
- The purpose is to provide coastal protection and flood damage reduction in keeping with the broader Chicago Shoreline Protection Project.

Project Overview

- The Project is approximately one (1) mile long and is bounded on the North by a recently completed project in 2013 (42nd to 45th Streets shoreline revetment project), on the South by another completed project in 2000 (51st to 54th Streets shoreline revetment project), on the West by a narrow strip of parkland and DuSable Lake Shore Drive, and on the East by Lake Michigan.
- Will add approximately 9.5 acres of new usable parkland and includes various type of revetments (Armor Stone, Dynamic Cobble, and Sheet Pile/Stepped Concrete Revetments).
- Additional features include:
 - New and reconfigured lake front pedestrian trail and bike path
 - New utilities
 - New lighting
 - New restroom
 - Salvage and re-use of existing materials
 - New landscaping, including sod, trees, and native planting
 - New signage
 - New viewing lookouts at 47th street and 49th street
- The estimated construction value is \$110 \$135 Million



- <u>discuss</u> the findings <u>and agree</u> on an overall consensus score that will help determine Final Recommendation of Pre-Qualified Bidders

The **Final Recommendation** is submitted to the PBC Board of Commissioners for approval at the PBC Board of Commissioners Meeting






